Briscoe Park

This 42 acre park features: Two lighted soccer fields, Two lighted football fields, Concession building with restrooms, ½ mile walking path that connects to Alvin Community College, 1.7 acre Dog Park, All-inclusive playground, Three picnic pavilions with tables, a Fishing pond, and Plenty of open green space.

Disc Golf Course

This 42 acre course is located Brisco Park. The lighted course is immersed in nature with 18 holes and walking trail access. Course lights are on from dusk to 10:30pm. 3625 Briscoe Drive

Historic Depot Centre and the Tom Blakeney Jr Hike & Bike Trail

This facility was built in 1907 and the exterior and interior have been renovated. Rental of the Historic Depot Centre and Clock Tower grounds are available. The Tom Blakeney Jr Hike and Bike Trail begins at this location

Hugh Adams Park

This 1 acre park features cyclone fence around the perimeter, seven picnic pavilions, playgrounds for ages 2-5 and 5-12, access to walking trail and drinking fountain.

Lions Park

This 7.5 acre park features: 7 multi-purpose athletic fields, 4 lighted fields, Walking/jogging trail, and Restrooms. 1060 College Drive, Alvin

Morgan Park

This 10 acre park has one lighted adult softball field and one lighted youth field, restrooms, parking lot, playground equipment, 2 sand volleyball courts, swings, picnic tables, and plenty of beautiful oak trees.

1500 West South Street, Alvin

National Oak Park

This 8 acre park is home to the Alvin Skate Park, Rotary Pavilion, National Oak Tree, origination of the Hike and Bike Trail, 7 other covered pavilions with picnic tables, swing set, two drinking fountains, playground and convenient parking.

Newman Park

This 2.5 acre park has plenty of oak trees, playground equipment, swings, basketball court, covered pavilion, picnic tables, parking, drinking fountain and a baseball athletic field with backstop.

Pearson Park

This 24 acre park is the largest sport complex in town. Restrooms, drinking fountains, picnic tables, 5 pavilions, 9 multi-purpose lighted athletic fields, 2 concession stands, 2 tennis courts, playground equipment, swings and bleachers.

Prairie Dog Park

This 1.1 acre park has aplayground, swings, picnic tables, parking and Hike and Bike Trail.

Ruben Adame Park

This 1.7 acre park includes swings, playground equipment, pavilion, picnic tables, drinking fountain, walking trail, basketball court, and baseball athletic field with a backstop.

This 1.7 acre park is shaded with beautiful trees, playground equipment, swings, picnic tables, basketball court and drinking fountain.
