





















Anna is located on State Highway 5, Farm Road 455, and U.S Highway 75 eleven miles northeast of McKinney in north central Collin County. Although Collin McKinney settled within a few miles of the future townsite in 1846, John L. Greer, who arrived in 1867, is credited with building the first home and store in the new community. The Houston and Texas Central Railway, at that time built between Dallas and Denison, passed through the area in 1873. By the time Anna was platted in 1883, it had a population of twenty, two stores, a steam gristmill, and a Baptist church. A post office also opened in that year. By 1890 the town had a population of 100 to 200. Anna was incorporated in 1913, with John L. Greer as first mayor. Source: annatexas.gov





Parks & Recreation

Slayter Creek Park

Located west of Anna Middle School at 425 West Rosamond Parkway and includes a variety of recreational amenities including: four lighted ball fields, two tennis courts, two basketball goals, two large multi-purpose athletic fields, a 3,600 foot walking trail, a skateboard park, a playground, horseshoe pits, a shuffleboard court, a splash pad, disc golf course, a large pavilion, gazebo, and a concession building with restrooms.

Slayter Creek Trail

The trail includes a 4,400 foot walking trail that connects the Slayter Creek Park trail to Hackberry Drive. Look for the coyote tracks at "Coyote Crossing" along the southern half of the trail. This is a portion of a larger trail system that will eventually run almost the entire length (north to south) of the city. It will ultimately connect many of our residential and recreational areas together with pedestrian access.

Natural Springs Park

Located just south of West White Street, (FM 455), behind Brookshire's. The park has several amenities including walking trails, a man-made pond, fishing pier and a large open area. It is a wonderful park to have a picnic, enjoy a leisurely stroll or other passive activities such as throwing balls, flying kites and pitching frisbees. New in 2019, Natural Springs Paw Park, an off-leash area for our furry neighbors, is now open. The Paw Park includes big and small dog areas, shade structures and agility equipment.

Bryant Park

Bryant Park is a 5-acre tract located on the north side of CR 371 just south of Bryant Elementary. Currently, the park is undeveloped, but in the future will be available for outdoor athletic and recreational activities.

Geer Park

Geer Park is a 25-acre tract located just east of the intersection of Sixth and Smith Streets. Like Bryant Park, this park is undeveloped, but in the future will be available for outdoor athletic and recreational activities.

Sherley Heritage Park

The park is Anna's most historical park celebrating Anna's location along the rail line. Located at the corner of Sherley Avenue and 4th Street, the park features a community-built, train-themed playground, newly restored train depot and pavilion. In December, Christmas in the Park, the City's annual Christmas tree lighting ceremony event, is held.

Johnson Park

Located just east of Sherley Avenue at 1st street. The park features 2 softball fields where the youth league traditionally plays and a playground.
