Caves and Caverns

Cascade Cavern

Devil's Sinkhole

A massive 350-foot-deep limestone pit, home to one of Texas' largest bat colonies. Guided tours provide insight into its geology, history, and the spectacular nightly bat emergence.

Enchanted Rock Cave

Fredericksburg | tpwd.texas.gov

A small but intriguing cave beneath Enchanted Rock offers an off-the-beaten-path adventure. Its cool, shadowy interior is a hidden gem for explorers in the state park.

Gorman Falls

San Saba | tpwd.texas.gov

Located in Colorado Bend State Park, this stunning 70-foot waterfall is surrounded by unique limestone cave formations. While the caves are not open for general tours, they add to the park's scenic beauty.

Inner Space Cavern

Discovered in 1960 during highway construction, this spectacular cave features massive stalactites, stalagmites, and formations like the "Lake of the Moon" and "The Cathedral." One of the most accessible caves in Texas.

Kickapoo Cavern

Brackettville | tpwd.texas.gov

A hidden gem within a 1,000-acre state park, featuring stunning formations and a large bat population. Guided tours showcase the cave's unique geology and diverse wildlife.

Loughorn Cavern

Burnet | visitloughorncavern.com

A historic cave formed over millions of years, known for dramatic limestone formations and a rich past as a Confederate stronghold and outlaw hideout. Tours highlight its fascinating chambers.

Natural Bridge Caverns

New Braunfels | naturalbridgecaverns.com

This is the largest show cave in Texas, featuring towering stalactites, stalagmites, and flowstone formations. Visitors can explore vast chambers and enjoy adventure activities like a ropes course.

Wonder World Cave

San Marcos | wonderworldpark.com

A unique cave with rare formations, discovered in the late 19th century. As part of Wonder World Park, visitors can explore underground chambers and enjoy additional attractions like an observation tower and train ride.
