Parks & Recreation

Bluebonnet

This 47-acre park and athletic complex includes 8 lighted diamonds, 10 acres of open green space, playgrounds, covered pavilion, picnic gazebos, concession stands, restroom facilities, and a large fishing pond with an adjacent 3/4 mile walking trail.

Disk Golf Course

18 Hole course positioned in a woody area with few open fairways. All Baskets have been updated and tee boxes renovated with concrete pads and signage with maps and distances.

I.O.O.F Park

Park at Fairview is a 5.25 park with 2 baseball fields, newly installed playground, and 1/2 mile walking trail. Baseball field complete with dugouts and stands. A brand new pavilion equipped with lights, electrical outlets, and picnic tables is available for family and community events.

Kachina Prairie Park

35 acre Nature trail located on the east side of Lake Clark. A rare and undisturbed park of the Blackland Prairie eco-region.

Kiwanis Park

Located along the southern edge of Old City Lake.

Lake Clark Park

Shoreline park surrounded by a 156 acre public body of water.

Lions Park

1/2 Mile paved walking path featuring the Ennis Library's story walk with 20 different reading stations. Pavilion, Playground, Used book exchange, and fishing.

Minnie McDowal

A gazebo serves as the place to meet up when shopping or out for a bite with family and friends. Throughout the year, the gazebo is used for art displays, community functions, and live music events.

119 Dallas Street

Rotary Park

Two beautiful party pavilions, brand new playground, beach volleyball courts, tennis, and baseball. Picnic at one of the shaded gazebos in the area. The park surrounds historic Old City Lake as the one-mile paved Ivan Goodwin Walking Trail connects to the adjoining Kiwanis Park.

Rogers & Maise Park

3.8 acre park houses an adult softball field with backstop, dugouts, and enclosed outfield fence with foul poles. The complex also contains 3 lighted basketball half-courts, playground, and fixed restroom facilities.

Historic Community Center. Estate for birthday parties, baby showers meetings, and classes.
