Frisco is a city in Texas and part of the Dallas-Fort Worth metro area. The city population was 116,989 at the 2010 census. The 2018 Census estimate placed the city population at 188,170. Frisco was the fastest-growing city in the United States in 2017

Downtown, the Frisco Heritage Museum displays antiques, vintage cars and railroad memorabilia. The National Videogame Museum has rare gaming consoles and arcade machines. Next door, Sci-Tech Discovery Center offers hands-on exhibits for kids. To the northeast, Frisco Commons Park features playgrounds, a fishing pond and an amphitheater.

# ANNUAL EVENTS

## Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival

The Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival is an award-winning multi-day eclectic arts and music festival that draws thousands of attendees to Galatyn Park urban center. Festival programming includes six performance stages that feature national, regional and local bands, the Singer/Songwriter contest and stage, the Wildflower! Kids area, Wildflower!
