Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival The Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival is an award-winning multi-day eclectic arts and music festival that draws thousands of attendees to Galatyn Park urban center. Festival programming includes six performance stages that feature national, regional and local bands, the Singer/Songwriter contest and stage, the Wildflower! Kids area, Wildflower! Eats, the Market Place, the Art Guitar Auction, and interactive entertainment area.
