Lampasas is a small town on the northeastern edge of the Texas Hill Country. It was established as a permanent settlement in 1850 by John Bureson and was officially incorporated in 1883. The town is home to seven mineral springs, so it was a popular tourist attraction and encampment site in the late 19th century. The town is only 6.2 square miles, with a population around 8,000 people, but don't let its size fool you. There's a lot going on in this Hill Country gem!
