




## Veterans Day Parade

Mansfield Independent School District is a premiere school district located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The district encompasses more than 94 square miles serving students in the city of Mansfield and sections of Arlington, Grand Prairie, Burleson, Fort Worth, Venus, Alvarado and Kennedale.

Mansfield ISD has 49 schools serving more than 35,000 students - one pre-kindergarten academy, 24 elementary schools (grades K-4), seven intermediate schools (grades 5-6), seven middle schools (grades 7-8), two standalone STEM academies, five traditional high schools, one career and technology academy, one alternative education center and one early college high school.
