Many amateur and professional photographers and artists come to capture the natural beauty of the Highland Lakes area.

Johnson Park

230 S. Avenue This park is located where Backbone Creek and Whitman Branch flow into Lake Marble Falls. It includes picnic tables, barbeque pits, a softball field, beach volleyball court, hike and bike trail and a boat ramp.

Westside Park

intersection of 2nd St. and Avenue Q. The park is 13 acres of fun and relaxation located along Backbone Creek. It includes picnic tables, barbeque grills, a fenced dog park, tetherballs, swings, hike and bike trail and a disc golf course.

Falls Creek Park and Skatepark 900 Yett Street

This park adjoins Lakeside Park on the east and Johnson Park on the west. There are several picnic tables, barbeque pits, a canoe-launch area and restroom facilities. The Skatepark is a 12,000-square-foot concrete and granite park with a number of unique features and elements such as The Parthenon Loop, the Double-Dorito Hip, the Bowless Corner and the Rainbow Rail.

Lakeside Park

Located on beautiful Lake Marble Falls where the calm waters of the lake provide a perfect course for one of the largest drag boat races in the country. It includes a swimming pool, covered picnic tables, barbeque pits, tennis court, basketball court and boat ramp.

Villa Vista Park
