Berkner Park
10 acres at 1800 E Spring Valley Rd and N Yale Blvd
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field and two athletic fields. Restroom facilities.

Breckinridge Park
417.13 acres at 5300 Renner Rd and N Brand Rd
Multi-use trail, picnic and playground equipment, two pavilions, one gazebo, 12 soccer fields, two softball fields, three ponds, and natural areas. Restroom facilities. Remaining area undeveloped.

Buckingham Park
0.25 acres at 401 E Buckingham Rd and Whitehall Dr
Two shelters, permanent marker of the Town of Buckingham

Bush Central Barkway (Dog Park)
3581 N Central Expwy Open 6:30am - 10:30pm
This six-acre site includes separate areas for large and small dogs, and for puppy parents who wish to host a doggy birthday party, a rental area is available.

Campbell Ridge Park
5.4 acres at 550 W Campbell Rd and Custer Pkwy Walkways

Canyon Creek Park
8.98 acres at 600 Aspenwood Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, swimming pool, baby pool, one lighted baseball field and two tennis courts.

CityLine Park
5.75 acres of green space for passive recreation at 3451 Routh Creek Pkwy and E Renner Rd. Extension of the Central Trail; connects with the CityLine DART station.
Elevated boardwalk with seating area. Architecturally unique pavilion. Monarch butterfly friendly landscape plants.

Collins Park
650 E. Collins Blvd.
Pocket park with shelter and walking trail. Connects to Central Trail.

Cottonwood Park
25.31 acres at 1301 W Belt Line Rd and S Cottonwood Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, two pavilions, two lakes, swimming pool, baby pool, two lighted tennis courts, sand volleyball court, 1.1 miles of trails, and multi-use concrete court. Restroom facilities.

Creek Hollow Park
8.7 acres at 4100 Breckinridge Blvd
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, multi-use court, horseshoe pits, one softball field, one athletic field, and a 1-acre natural area preserving the existing trees and creek on the property. Restroom facilities.

Crowley Park
58.53 acres at 2700 N Spring Dr
Naturalistic areas, two athletic fields, playground equipment, pavilion, pond, and deck. Restroom facilities.

Custer Park
7.02 acres at 701 W Renner Rd and Custer Pkwy
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field, athletic field, and two lighted tennis courts.
Restroom facilities.

Duck Creek Linear Park
26.26 acres at 1800 Apollo Rd, located along Duck Creek Trail, from Jupiter Rd and Ponderosa Dr to N Plano Rd
Multi-use trail, plaza with playground equipment, picnic facilities, and lakes. Trail links with Owens Trail.

Foxboro Park

8.9 acres at 2600 N Plano Rd and Braeburn Dr
Naturalistic areas, shelter, and playground equipment.



Fox Creek Park

Located at the 1500 block of Renner Rd
Concrete hike & bike trail with open spaces on either side for a friendly game of family football, and places to rest during halftime. Playground equipment for 2-5 & 5-12 year olds, with adjacent pavilion. 70' long pedestrian bridge, providing a convenient creek crossing.

Galatyn Woodland Preserve

8 acres at 911 E Lookout Dr (located east of the DART light-rail line)
Multi-use trail, picnic areas, animal sculpture playground, boardwalk for bird-watching, wetland ponds, and three horseshoe pits. Trail links with Spring Creek Nature Area to the north and Galatyn Park Plaza to the south.

Glenville Park

7.5 acres at 500 S Glenville Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, swimming pool, splash playground, one baseball field, and two athletic fields.

Heights Park

33 acres at 711 W Arapaho Rd and S Floyd Rd
Picnic and playground equipment, two shelters, recreation center, swimming pool, splash playground, two lighted baseball fields, small backstops, two athletic fields, two lighted tennis courts.

Huffhines Park

54.54 acres at 200 N Plano Rd and Apollo Rd
Picnic and playground equipment, pavilion, recreation center, six lighted baseball fields, small backstops, six athletic fields, tennis center with 10 lighted courts, concession complex, two lakes and bike/hike trail.

Lookout Park

25 acres at 1600 E Lookout Dr and Owens Blvd
Three athletic fields, play equipment, pavilion. Restroom facilities. Links with Owens Trail and Lookout Trail.

Mark Twain Park

8.95 acres at 1200 Larkspur Dr and N Glenville Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one lighted baseball field, one athletic field, and two lighted tennis courts.

McKamy Spring Park

1.94 acres at 643 Brick Row
Multi-use trail, picnic and playground equipment.

Memorial Park

0.84 acres at 555 Centennial Blvd and Grove Rd
Memorial to Armed Forces personnel.

Mimosa Park

9.41 acres at 1200 Mimosa Dr and Apache Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one lighted baseball field, small backstop, one athletic field, and two lighted tennis courts. Restroom facilities.

Northrich Park

1 acre park at 525 Malden Dr and Custer Road.
Features walking trail, outdoor classroom, drinking fountain, pavilion with picnic tables, and new playground.

Point North Park

5.49 acres at 725 Synergy Park Blvd
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field, and one athletic field. Restroom facilities.

Prairie Creek Park

37.25 acres at 2305 W Prairie Creek Dr and Campbell Rd
Picnic areas, natural areas.

Richland Park

7.37 acres at 500 Park Bend Dr and Lois Ln
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field, small backstops, one athletic field, sand volleyball court, and two tennis courts.

Ruth Back Toler Park

21.869 acres at 4805 E Renner Rd in Breckinridge Park
Natural area and trails.

Ruth Young Park

0.3 acres at 200 W Belt Line Rd/Main St and Central Expressway
Flower garden for viewing.



Spring Creek Nature Area

51 acres at 3110 N Central Expwy, south of Renner Rd, extending from Central Expressway to Foxboro Park, at Plano Rd and Braeburn Dr
Multi-use trail, natural areas, hardwood forest, pedestrian bridge over winding Spring Creek, picnic benches, horseshoe pit. Trail links with Galatyn Woodland Preserve.

Terrace Park

10.24 acres at 200 Lois Ln and LaSalle Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, swimming pool, baby pool, one lighted baseball field, small backstops, one athletic field, and two lighted tennis courts.

Woodhaven Grove Park

3.32 acres at 713 S Grove Rd/Audelia Rd and Centennial Blvd
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter.

Woodland Park

5.92 acres at 1200 Woodland Way
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one lighted baseball field, small backstops, one athletic field, and two lighted tennis courts. Restroom facilities.

Woods Park

6.99 acres at 3408 Springbranch Dr and Telecom Pkwy
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, natural areas, 0.8 mile multi-use trail along Beck Branch Creek, and a 50' pedestrian bridge.

Wyndson Park

10 acres at 3106 Hartford Dr and Carrington Dr
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field, multi-use court, and open sports field. Restroom facilities.

Yale Park

7.5 acres at 1900 E Collins Blvd and N Yale Blvd
Picnic and playground equipment, shelter, one baseball field, one athletic field, and two tennis courts. Restroom facilities.



ANNUAL EVENTS

Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival

The Wildflower! Arts and Music Festival is an award-winning multi-day eclectic arts and music festival that draws thousands of attendees to Galatyn Park urban center. Festival programming includes six performance stages that feature national, regional and local bands, the Singer/Songwriter contest and stage, the Wildflower! Kids area, Wildflower! Eats, the Market Place, the Art Guitar Auction, and interactive entertainment area.

Cottonwood Art Festival

Established in 1969, Cottonwood Art Festival is a bi-annual event featuring works from some of the nation's top visual artists. A juried show with 240 artists, Cottonwood showcases art media in 14 different categories such as 2D and 3D mixed media, ceramics, digital, and drawings/pastels. The festival also features local bands and food available in the courtyard. There is also Artstop, an interactive children's creative playground featuring activities and arts and crafts for kids of all ages. Takes first full weekend in May and October.

Huffhines Art Trails

A fall tradition dating back to 1976, the Huffhines Art Trails is an annual arts and crafts show featuring 170 of the areas finest artisans. Patrons will find a variety of contemporary crafts, traditional crafts, and art in mediums that range from painting and pottery to glass, wood work and jewelry, a perfect place to start your holiday shopping.

Pawtoberfest

Enjoy live music, delicious food and adorable pups at this all-day dog-friendly event at Huffhines Park. Make sure to register your favorite four-legged friend for one of the competitive events such as the costume contest and pet look-alike contest. Pawtoberfest takes place at Huffhines Park, 1500 Apollo Rd in Richardson.

Santa's Village

The area's best kept holiday secret, Santa's Village is a heartwarming event for the young and the young at heart. Venture up to the North Pole (the lawn at City Hall) and explore Santa's Village and even visit Ol' Saint Nick himself! The village is made up of seventeen special houses including Ms. Claus' Bakery, the Reindeer Shed, Frosty's House, and the Ornament Factory, just to name a few. Santa's Village is opened for ten nights in December.

Richardson's Annual Christmas Parade

The Richardson Christmas Parade is an annual event which takes place the first Saturday in December. The route is alternated each year from the East and West side of town. Kids of all ages, community clubs and families are encouraged to participate in this Richardson tradition.
