Parks & Recreation

Freedom Dog Park

Freedom Dog Park is an 8.3 acre "leash free" zone for furry, four-footed canine friends. The dog park includes large and small dog fenced sections to help ensure pet safety by grouping like-sized dogs in separate fenced areas. Freedom Dog Park features a wooded "natural" section and open areas to allow dogs and owners relief from the heat while enjoying a truly outdoor experience.

Harmony Park

Harmony Park is a 13-acre multi-use park located at the far end of Indian Creek, where the road comes to a dead end on the back side of Hogan's Glen. The park features a playground, nine soccer fields, two tennis courts and a basketball court. The soccer fields are available to the Greater Northwest Soccer Association only and a concession stand offers snacks during league-play, plenty of space to allow children to have fun in full view of adults at the pool.

Independence Park

Independence Park spans both sides of Parkview, which separates Independence Park West (Indy West) and Independence Park East (Indy East). Total, the park covers 23 acres and is dedicated to youth sports and outdoor recreation activities.

Trophy Club Park

Trophy Club Park is a true outdoor adventure with over 877 acres of fun! Located at the northwestern tip of Grapevine Lake, Trophy Club Park is a heavily wooded park with some open space for events and various activities. A boat launch provides access to the lake and a major draw to the park are seven miles of motorized trails for MX and ATV use. Trophy Club Park truly has something for everyone!

Trophy Club Community Pool

The Trophy Club Community Pool offers a 188,000 gallon competition pool with a diving board, as well as a 34,000 gallon baby pool with baby-centric water features and a small slide. In 2010, a one-of-a-kind pirate themed hybrid splash pad was constructed featuring an island slide, water spraying palm tree, water shooting marine animals, a cannon, and a water dragon.
