

Recreation

C.K. Ray Recreation Center

A full fitness facility featuring racquetball courts, gymnasium, locker rooms, cardio fitness room, child care room, weight room, and fitness classes for all levels. The cardio fitness room is equipped with elliptical trainers, treadmills and upright recumbent bikes. The weight room has a variety of machines and free weights. Also offered at The REC are special interest classes including gymnastics, karate, and dance; athletic programs for all ages; and rental capabilities for those parties or receptions.

Conroe Aquatic Center

This 87,120 sq. ft. waterpark features a children's wading pool with zero-depth beach entry and an aquatic play unit complete with a slide, tumble buckets, sprayers and more. The new, multi-story slide towers contain five colorful twisting and speed slide options. The adjacent youth-adult pool brings the fun with volleyball and a basketball goal and showcases a relaxing shallow water sun ledge complete with loungers. 1205 Candy Cane Lane, Conroe

Oscar Johnson Jr. Community Ctr

A six thousand square foot building with meeting facilities, classrooms, computer lab, kitchen and offices supports the Center's programming efforts to address the needs in the community. A four thousand square foot activity building adds a game room, an art studio, restrooms and a large meeting room for programs and rental opportunities. Outdoor features include a lighted basketball court, playground area, picnic tables and seasonal swimming pool. 100 Park Pl, Conroe

Senior Center

This 60+ Senior Center offers opportunities for seniors to socialize through games, painting, crafts, movie days and bingo. Coffee and light snacks are available each day. Westside Recreation Center

Parks

Booker T. Washington Park

This park was formerly known as First Street Park and is leased from Conroe Independent School District. In 2014 the park was renamed Booker T. Washington Park. The baseball fields, concession building and playground were raised to make room for a lighted multi-use field with spectator seating, a concession/pavilion/restroom building for group functions, a shaded play structure, a basketball court, picnic areas and a walking path.

Candy Cane Park

This 24 acre park is Conroe's most well known park. It began as the City & VFW Park and has grown into a popular destination that includes the Heritage Museum of Montgomery County, ADA compliant playgrounds, pavilions, picnic areas, the C.K. Ray Recreation Center, Six tennis courts and the Conroe Aquatic Center. Aquatics Center that features two instructional pools and a splash/spray pool. 1204 Candy Cane Lane, Conroe

Carl Barton, Jr. Park

This park is not only used for soccer and baseball games, but it is also very popular for reunions, birthday parties as well as picnics while fishing in the ponds. 2500 S. Loop 336, Conroe

Conroe Founders Plaza

This 0.6 acre park features a covered stage for performances, landscaping, picnic tables and a water feature. 205 Metcalf Street, Conroe

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Park

The park is a 25 acre state of the art park. A pavilion, restroom facilities, a hard surface-walking trail, and also complete with ADA compliant playground.

Flournoy Park

This 4 acre park east of downtown Conroe with an ADA compliant playground, a full size basketball court, and picnic area. 413 Tenth Street, Conroe

Heritage Place

This 2.5 acre public space is capable of accommodating events as diverse as public gardening, crafts and cooking fairs, wedding receptions as well as a venue for outdoor events, festivals, and concerts. 500 Metcalf Street, Conroe

John Burge Park at Shadow Lakes This 39 acre park located on the City's northwest side with rolling terrain features a large pavilion for group functions, picnic areas, an outdoor learning center with amphitheater style seating, a playground, waterless restroom facility, native landscaping, a 5,700 gallon rainwater harvest system, and over a mile trail network system. This park also features an eighteen basket championship disc golf course and "The Magnolia Tree" by Conroe artist Craig Campobella. 11050 Little Egypt Road, Conroe

Kasmiersky Park

Kasmiersky Park features an ADA compliant playground, two pavilions, a lighted multi-use field, an off-leash area, picnic areas, 1/2 mile lighted walking trail, and a skate park. Live oak trees and pine trees offer plenty of shade for picnickers. 889 Old Magnolia Road, Conroe

Lake Conroe Park

This 13-acre park offers picnic tables & BBQ pits, plus fishing piers & a roped-off swimming area. 14968 TX-105, Montgomery

Sam Houston National Forest

The Sam Houston National Forest spans Lake Conroe's northern shores and is home to towering pines and plenty of maintained trails for hiking, biking, and wildlife watching, along with horseback riding and dirt biking trails.

Hiking is a popular way to enjoy the forest and its beauty. The 128-mile Lone Star Hiking Trail, a portion of which has gained National Recreation Trail status, winds through the Sam Houston National Forest. The trail, marked with two-inch by four-inch aluminum markers to guide hikers, has recreation areas available at three different points.

Camping - There are three developed campgrounds in the Sam Houston National Forest (Cagle, Double Lake & Stubblefield Recreation Areas). Cagle and Double Lake facilities are available by reservations or on a first-come, first-served basis if not previously reserved. Reservations for Cagle may be made at the recreation area or by calling the National Recreation Service. Stubblefield is available on a first-come, first-served basis only. Reservations can be completed by calling the National Recreation Service at 877-444-6777 or at www.recreation.gov.

Canoes and paddleboats can be rented at the concession stand at Double Lake which also has groceries, ice, and other items for sale. Bass, bream, and catfish have been stocked in Double Lake, and fishing is permitted under applicable state laws. Only small electric motors are allowed on the lake. Double Lake Recreation Area also provides access to the Lone Star Hiking Trail.

Fishing - On the northeast boundary of the forest lies the 82,600-acre Lake Livingston. Lake Conroe, to the southwest, offers 22,000 acres of water-oriented recreation. Both lakes are noted for black bass and year round fishing. The Forest Service provides three access points to Lake Conroe. A boat slip on the San Jacinto River near Stubblefield Recreation Area north on the lake, a boat ramp along the northeastern shore of Lake Conroe at Cagle Recreation Area, and another boat ramp is at Scotts Ridge on the southwestern shore of the lake.

Hunting - The entire Sam Houston National Forest is designated as a wildlife management area through a cooperative agreement between Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and the U.S. Forest Service. This special designation provides benefits to those who use the Sam Houston National Forest, including hunters, and to the wildlife that live or forage there. Extra fees paid by hunters who use wildlife management areas are collected by Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and are returned to the Forest Service for use in those areas.

Multiple-use Trails - The Sam Houston National Forest offers 85 miles of multiple-use trails designated and developed for hiking, biking, horses, and registered Off-Highway Vehicles (OHVs). Offering a variety of unique riding conditions, the multiple-use trail in the Sam Houston is the only trail open to OHVs in the National Forests in Texas. To promote sustainable and safe riding opportunities, trails are closed when conditions such as soil moisture could lead to trail damage. Before visiting please call the Ranger's Office at 936-344-6205 or 888-361-6908 and select option 2 for trail status.

Lewis Park

This 5 acre neighborhood park was developed in 1978. It was redeveloped in 1999 with ADA compliant playground equipment, a pavilion, and additional parking. 501 Park Place, Conroe

Lions Park

This 3.5 acre park located in the Robinwood Subdivision. Features a pavilion, picnic tables, athletic field, basketball court, play structure, and a 1/4 mile trail. 1851 N. Hampton, Conroe

The Lone Star Monument & Flag Park

The monument at the 3.5-acre park is a circular landscaped plaza surrounded by 13 flags that flew in Texas as the region fought for independence during the Texas Revolution. At the center of the plaza is The Texian, a 14-foot-tall bronze sculpture by Conroe artist Craig Campobella. The statue depicts an average volunteer soldier of the Texas Revolution 104 I-45 North, Conroe

McDade Park

This 38 acre park has a basketball court, restrooms, pavilion along with picnic tables, and a 18-hole Disc Golf Course was introduced. 10310 FM 2854, Conroe


Milltown Park
