 Hamilton Pool Preserve is a historic swimming hole which was designated a preserve by the Travis County Commissioner's Court in 1990. Located 3/4 mile upstream from its confluence with the Pedernales River, Hamilton Creek spills out over limestone outcroppings to create a 50 foot waterfall as it plunges into the head of a steep box canyon.

In addition to the fantastic art you will find a spring-fed pond, some of the largest oak trees in the City and over 20 different native species of plants. Falconhead West Primitive Park
 Located in the Falconhead West Neighborhood off of Patagonia Pass, this park boasts some of the best and at times technical single track in the area. The park is designed as a primitive hike and bike trail with views of the hill country, shaded benches along the trail. The trails are divided into four color-coded segments, ranging in length from .5 to 1.5 miles, approximately 3.6 miles total.

At that time, 541 students were enrolled in grades K-12. Since then, district enrollment has increased to approximately 11,000 students (October 2024) with 11 campuses.
