Coppell Historical Museum

Step into Coppell's past with a visit to the Coppell Historical Museum and Heritage Park, a one-acre site operated by the Coppell Historical Society featuring historic structures such as the 1904 Kirkland House, the 1924 Ihnfeldt House, the 1947 Wilson House, and a replica of one of the original Minyard's grocery stores. Modeled after the first Minyard's in east Dallas and relocated to the park in 2011, the store now sells vintage gifts, historic postcards, and nostalgic treats from the early 1900s.
