Forest Hill is a welcoming Fort Worth suburb in Tarrant County with roots stretching back to the 1860s. What began as a small settlement known as Brambleton Station has grown into a thriving community that officially incorporated in 1946 and achieved city status just three years later. Residents enjoy easy access to Memorial Park, the Forest Hill Civic Convention Center, and a dedicated library and senior center that anchor community life. With a rich heritage that includes being a stop on an early electric railway line, Forest Hill blends small-town charm with proximity to Fort Worth's urban amenities.
