Carl Levin Park
The park offers a welcoming outdoor space centered around a scenic pond where ducks can often be seen. The park features a variety of recreational amenities, including a playground, basketball courts, and a community garden. Visitors can enjoy walking trails and open green spaces ideal for walking, running, and general fitness activities. Additional conveniences include picnic tables, restrooms, and a splash-friendly water pad. Located adjacent to a swimming pool, the park is easy to access and well-equipped with ample shade and comfortable seating throughout.

Athletic/Community park on 62 acres with four softball fields and four baseball fields, lighted walking/jogging trail, playground equipment, picnic units, open play area and restroom facilities. The Kyle Hilliard Trail at Community Park is 1 mile long.

Goode-Connell Park
This 14 acre neighborhood park will include an exercise trail, playground area, picnic tables, open play area, park benches, and practice fields for soccer and baseball/softball. The walking trail is 3/5 mile long.
