Bishop Park
Amenities: Historical marker, creek observation deck, picnic tables with B.B.Q. grills

City Hall Park
Amenities: Children's play structures, tennis court, sand volleyball court, back stop for a practice field, and covered pavilion with B.B.Q. grill.

Justin Community Park
Amenities: Walking trail, children's play structures, three baseball/coed softball fields, one youth softball, soccer fields, and a 9-hole disc golf course.
