Parks & Recreation

Back Alley Plaza

One-acre plaza in the heart of downtown Midlothian and adjacent to the Old Firehouse. Beautifully landscaped with trees and flowers, with parking.
152 Plaza Drive, Midlothian

Civic Center Park

Six-acre park with large multi-purpose fields and restrooms. It is home to Midlothian Youth Football League and is not available for rent through the city.

Hawkins Spring Park

A 21.7-acre community park with nine lighted and irrigated soccer fields, concession stand, public picnic tables, playground, water fountain, public restrooms, and a public skate park.

Heritage Park

A quiet and peaceful downtown park, landscaped with beautiful flower beds, lots of shade trees, a walking path, and several benches and chairs for seating.

Jaycee Park

Ten-acre community park with 5 lighted baseball fields, bleachers, concession stand, playground, restrooms, and two public picnic tables.

Kimmel Park

A 2.9-acre, fenced community park located in the center of downtown. Kimmel Park has a charming bandstand, picnic pavilion, 1/4-mile perimeter walking trail, benches, water fountain, two shaded playgrounds, picnic tables, restrooms, and lots of shade trees.

Lake Grove Park

Situated on the north shore of Texas Conservation Service Site 5 reservoir, Lake Grove Park features a 2,500-foot concrete walking trail combined with a natural-surface trail from Hawkins Run Road to South 14th Street with entrances at both ends. Amenities also include a lakeshore boardwalk and benches. Catch-and-release fishing only is allowed. Small, non-motorized craft may be used, but no swimming is allowed. The park was designed to be accessed on foot or by bicycle and has no vehicle parking.

Leta Lundberg Park (formerly Ridgeview Park)

An 8.6-acre community park, featuring two picnic areas, two park benches, toddler-friendly playground, and walking trail.

Margie Webb Park

Peaceful 0.25-acre community park with a central pavilion, surrounded by landscaped trees and plenty of beautiful flowers, benches, a picnic table, and a toddler playground.

Midlothian Community Park

Phase one: 13 soccer fields, a football practice field, and a lighted competition field with home/visitor stands, a concession stand, 13 public picnic tables, restrooms, water fountains, playground, and walking trail.

Phase two: Features a splash pad supplied with fresh water, a large universal playground, a small playground, 2, 3-point basketball courts, a multipurpose court, 4 sand volleyball courts, an amphitheater with lawn seating, fishing pond, and 5 baseball fields for youth baseball league play.

Midlothian Dog Park

This four-acre park has separate areas for small and large dogs, agility equipment, 1/3-mile walking trail, restrooms, drinking fountain/bottle filler, lighting, and security cameras.

Midlothian Sports Complex

A 25-acre sports complex, maintained in cooperation with Midlothian Independent School District. It has four lighted softball fields, eight lighted tennis courts, a football field with quarter-mile track, a basketball court, four sand volleyball courts, concession stand, restrooms.

Mockingbird Nature Park

A 60-acre nature park with a hiking trail, public restrooms, butterfly garden, pond, bluebird nestboxes, boardwalk, and native grass areas. Equipped with Navilens markers that provide narrated and written information about the park's plants.

Mountain Peak Park

A 10-acre neighborhood park with a pavilion, half-mile walking path, playground, multi-slides, climbing area, and restrooms.

Triangle Park

A 0.18-acre State right-of-way located between US Hwy 287 and the U.S. Post Office.
