Parks & Rec

Cross Timbers Park

Cross Timbers Park is a 100.8-acre community park with lighted youth baseball fields, a 9-hole disc golf course, a playground, pavilions, along with paved and unpaved hike and bike trails. Much of the park's acreage is a dedicated preserve that is home to a variety of birds and wildlife.

Green Valley Park

Green Valley Community Park is a 30.06-acre community park with lighted soccer fields, fishing ponds, playground, walking trail, picnic pavilion, pickleball courts, restrooms and a concession building.

Fossil Creek Park

Fossil Creek Park is a 58.5-acre community park with multi-use athletic fields and soft surface mountain bike trails in a riparian forest preserve. To complement the mountain bike trails, construction of a bicycle playground and pump track was recently completed at the southwest corner of the park.

Linda Spurlock Park

This is a 14.5-acre neighborhood park features a playground, benches and swings, shaded pavilion with picnic tables, walking trail, practice fields, fishing pond and restrooms.

Northfield Park
