## Parks & Recreation

### Ashley Park

This 5-acre neighborhood park is a great place for families to play on the playground, practice soccer, or enjoy a pick-up game of basketball.

### Crescent Bend Nature Park

Spanning 180 acres, this park is a true escape into nature. Miles of winding trails, colorful wildflower blooms, and inviting picnic spots create the perfect outdoor retreat. Keep an eye out for rare birds from one of the two bird blinds, or head to Cibolo Creek and cast a line for a peaceful fishing experience.

### Cut-off Park

This 58-acre park features lots of open space, heritage-sized oak trees, and trailhead access to six miles of Cibolo Creek Primitive Trails.

### Cypress Point Park

This 10-acre neighborhood park features a playscape, walking trail, and lots of open space.

### Forest Ridge Park

Nestled within 14 acres, this park features a hidden-feeling trail that cuts through a linear forested area, making it a favorite for walkers and runners. The trail connects to the FM 3009 sidewalks and is planned to eventually link with the Schertz Parkway Trails. An open field offers flexible space for activities like pop-up soccer practices.

### Gutierrez Xeriscape Park

This 2-acre park features multiple garden areas beautifully maintained by the Guadalupe Master Gardeners volunteer group. The gazebo area is perfect for photo opportunities, and a shaded and lighted walking trail encircles the park.

### Heritage Oaks Park

This 13-acre park is a unique site, with hundreds of heritage-sized oak and cedar elm trees. This park offers a walking path through the woods, picnic facilities, and a picturesque pond.

### Mary Whitfield Burks Park

This 2-acre park is just off Schertz Parkway and can only be accessed on foot or by bicycle off of the Schertz Parkway trails. This pocket park has outdoor fitness equipment and a drinking fountain for runners and walkers.

### Oak Forest Park

This 2.5-acre neighborhood pocket park has numerous oak trees that provide a shaded canopy for the walking trail that meanders through the park. The walking trail connects to the FM 3009 sidewalks.

This small 2-acre pocket park borders Cibolo Creek and is mostly open space. The park is being developed by Eagle Scouts into a Scout Day Use Area with picnic facilities.

## Area Golf Courses

### Olympia Hills

18 Holes | Par 72 | 5,534 to 6,923 yards  
The course offers a memorable and challenging experience, highlighted by dramatic elevation changes on holes 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, and 13, with drops of 50 feet or more from tee to green. Golfers navigate a layout defined by naturally rolling terrain, thoughtfully placed man-made mounds, and strategically positioned bunkers, all set on well-maintained Bermuda grass. With four sets of tees ranging from 6,923 yards at the championship level to 5,534 yards from the forward tees, the course provides an enjoyable test for players of all skill levels. Throughout the round, golfers are immersed in native South Texas vegetation and wildlife, including some of the largest and most picturesque live oak trees in Bexar County.
