Parks & Recreation

Bearden Park

This 17.5-acre park is a dedicated destination for baseball enthusiasts, featuring eight baseball fields that host practices, games, and tournaments throughout the year. Visitors can enjoy the convenience of a concession stand, as well as separate men's and women's restroom facilities. Three covered 10-by-10-foot picnic tables provide comfortable spaces for families and teams to gather, while eight bleachers offer ample seating for spectators cheering on their favorite players.

Bruce Central Park

This expansive 35.5-acre community park offers a wide variety of recreational opportunities for visitors of all ages. Sports enthusiasts can enjoy two tennis courts, two softball fields, a football field, and a volleyball court, while the playground provides a fun space for children to explore and play. The park's scenic pond and half-mile trail create a relaxing environment for walking and enjoying the outdoors. Visitors can gather at 10 covered picnic tables, take advantage of eight barbecue grills, and enjoy the convenience of a concession stand and restroom facility. Spectators are well accommodated with eight bleachers with pavilions, six additional bleachers, and a two-story scorekeeper stand for sporting events. This destination serves as a popular gathering place for recreation, competition, and community events.

Casa Grande Park
