#### **Buescher State Park**

Nestled in the Lost Pines region just north of Smithville, Buescher State Park spans over 1,000 acres of scenic forest and lakefront. Visitors can enjoy hiking nearly six miles of trails, biking through wooded paths, fishing, kayaking, and camping. The park features a 30-acre lake, historic Civilian Conservation Corps structures, and a peaceful atmosphere perfect for nature lovers and families. Facilities include restrooms with showers, screened shelters, and cabins. It's also home to a Junior Ranger program for kids.
