The city is situated near Interstate 35 and adjacent to Joint Base San Antonio–Randolph, which has historically influenced local development and population growth. Universal City is primarily residential, with commercial areas, public parks, and community facilities serving local residents. City services include municipal governance, public safety, and recreational amenities, and the community is served by nearby school districts and regional transportation networks.

Aina Blake Dog Park

Northview Park and Splashpad
Northview Park is a half-acre neighborhood park that includes playground equipment set within a grassy area, along with shaded seating and benches. The park features a soccer field and a splash pad designed for seasonal use. The splash pad covers approximately 4,000 square feet and includes 16 water features arranged into three designated areas: Toddler Bay, Family Bay, and Teen Bay. Water elements include ground-level spray features, interactive structures, and larger water features intended for older users. The park provides recreational opportunities for a range of age groups and is used primarily during warmer months in the Universal City area.

Olympia Hills is a golf course located in Universal City that offers an outdoor wedding venue on its landscaped grounds. The property includes a clubhouse and banquet room with on-site food service. The facility provides event support and staffing for weddings and other gatherings. In addition to event space, Olympia Hills features an 18-hole golf course in the greater San Antonio area, along with a golf practice facility that includes a full-length driving range with target greens and a 10,000-square-foot short game area with a putting green, chipping area, and practice sand bunker. The course is maintained for play by golfers of varying skill levels, and professional golf instruction is available.

Randolph Oaks Golf Course offers a beautifully maintained 18-hole championship layout, open to golfers of all skill levels. The facility includes a lighted driving range and a well-kept putting green, perfect for sharpening your game day or night. Although it is located on Randolph AFB, requiring base access procedures. Non-DoD golfers can access the course, which is often ranked among top accessible military courses, by arranging for a guest pass at the visitor center or having a military sponsor.
