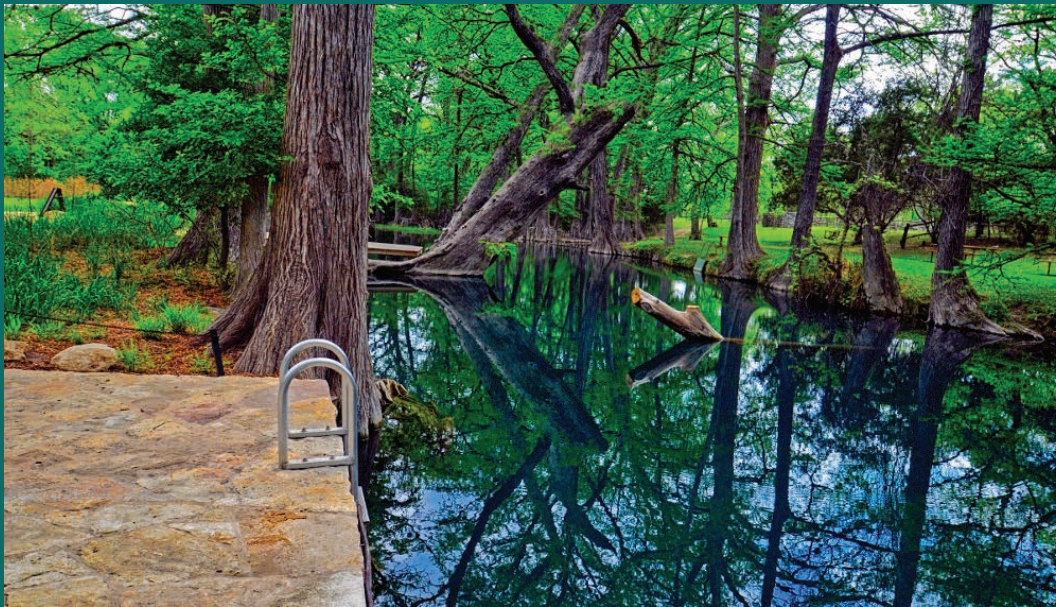

### Blue Hole Regional Park

A beloved Hill Country destination known for its crystal-clear spring-fed swimming hole and scenic natural beauty. Nestled along Cypress Creek, the park features towering cypress trees, limestone bluffs, and cool, clear waters that make it especially popular during the warm months. Beyond swimming, visitors can enjoy miles of well-maintained hiking and biking trails, shaded picnic areas, and open green spaces perfect for relaxing or exploring. ### Cypress Creek Nature Trail & Preserve

Offering a peaceful escape into the heart of the Hill Country, where native landscapes and quiet waterways take center stage. This protected area winds along Cypress Creek, featuring shaded walking trails, scenic overlooks, and opportunities to observe local wildlife in a natural, undisturbed setting. Designed with conservation in mind, the preserve emphasizes low-impact recreation, making it ideal for leisurely walks, birdwatching, and moments of reflection.

### Jacob's Well

This natural karstic spring is "fed by the Trinity Aquifer, which pushes up its water through the well and spills it into nearby Cypress Creek." It also happens to be the entrance of Texas's second longest fully-submerged cave, with plunging depths of 100 feet or more. Reservations are required to swim.

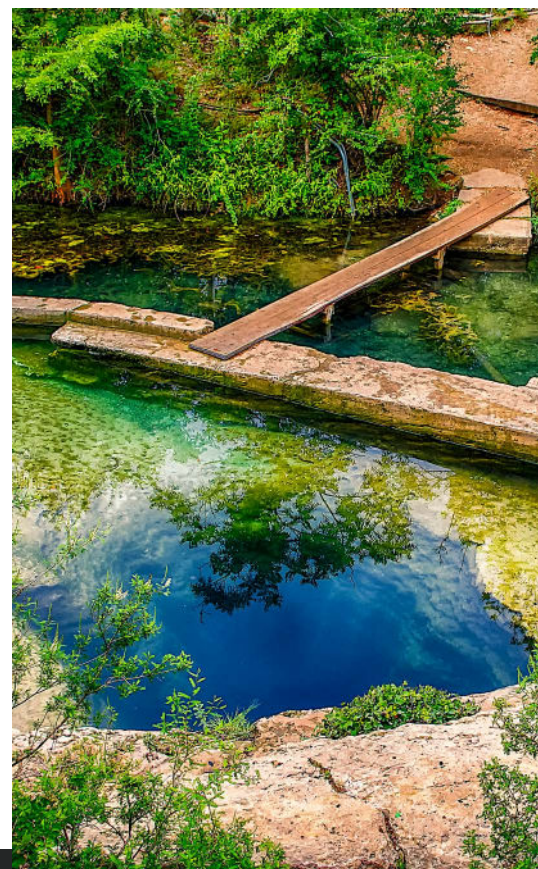
