250 years ago

in a boarding house in Philadelphia, a group of remarkable people came together around the idea that something new was possible – that the old order didn't have to be permanent. Thomas Jefferson put the words on paper, but the document that emerged belonged to a whole chorus of voices, people who had been arguing and dreaming and corresponding with each other for years. They pulled from philosophers they loved, but mostly they wrote from the marrow of a particular moment in time, when a community of dreamers decided to bet everything on an idea.



WE THE PEOPLE
insure domestic Tranquillity, provide for the common
and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Con
stitution.

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every thirty Thousand Persons.

Rhode Island and Providence Plantations one, Connecticut five, and the Town of Boston in the State of Massachusetts five, and Georgia three.

South Carolina five, and New York six.

Each State shall have the same Number of Senators as Representatives, but no State shall have less than three Senators, and each Senator shall have the same Qualifications as the Representatives.

The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Senator who shall not, when elected, be seven Years old, and seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who, when elected, shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

The Senate shall have the sole and exclusive Power of Impeachment.

The House of Representatives shall have the sole and exclusive Power of Impeachment, and the sole and exclusive Power of Judgment, except in the Case of Impeachment of a Judge, in which Case the Judgment shall not extend further than to remove him from Office.

The House of Representatives shall choose their Speakers and other Officers, and shall have the sole and exclusive Power of Origination, except Cases arising from the States.

The House of Representatives may impeach and try Judges, but no Person shall be tried during his Continuance in Office.
