Salado is a charming historic village in Bell County that perfectly captures the spirit of old Texas, with roots stretching back over 15,000 years to ancient Native American settlements. This quaint community was once a bustling stop on the legendary Chisholm Trail and is home to Texas's oldest continuously operating hotel, the Stagecoach Inn. Though the town's population dwindled when the railroads passed it by, Salado has preserved its rich heritage with 19 National Historic Register locations and maintains its appeal as a peaceful retreat along the natural springs of the Balcones Fault.
