CENTRAL TEXAS

Volente Beach Leander | volentebeach.com

On the shores of Lake Travis, Volente Beach features four slide attractions and pools that use natural lake water, plus a private beach area for guests. Its lakefront setting and intimate scale make it a popular choice for Austin-area families seeking a more relaxed water park experience.

Hawaiian Falls Pflugerville, Waco | hfalls.com

Six Flags Hurricane Harbor
