Blackhawk Golf Club

2714 Kelly Ln, Pflugerville
blackhawkgolf.com 18 Holes, Par 72

Measuring more than 7,000 yards from the championship tees, the course and slope ratings are 74.5 and 125 respectively. Blackhawk features a links-style layout that has proven tough enough to host several professional mini-tour events.

Bluebonnet Hill Golf Club

Bluebonnet Hill Golf Course offers players of all skill levels a challenging and enjoyable round of golf. The course is laid out over the rolling hills just 15 minutes east of downtown Austin on Decker Lane. The course is in excellent shape with impeccable 328 Bermuda greens.

Butler Park Pitch & Putt

Butler Park Pitch and Putt is a nine hole, par 3 course near downtown Austin, the Hike and Bike Trail, and Lady Bird Lake. It features large, shady pecan trees, water and grass traps, challenging holes, a very diverse clientele, and friendly and helpful employees.

Falconhead Golf Club

Jimmy Clay Golf Course

The Jimmy Clay Golf Course was constructed and opened in 1974; designed by noted golf course architect Joe Finger. Located in Southeast Austin and surrounded by Williamson Creek, the course plays 6,918 yards through traditional tree-lined fairways and elevated open greens.

Lions Municipal Golf Course

Constructed originally by the Lions Club in 1928, the Lions Club Municipal Golf Course has hosted many notable golfers, including Ben Hogan, Byron Nelson and, of course, Tom Kite and Ben Crenshaw.

Morris Williams Golf Course

The Morris Williams Golf Course is located near downtown Austin on East Manor Road. Enjoy views of the Austin skyline as you play the recently renovated golf course.

Riverside Golf Course

Roy Kizer Golf Course

With 35 acres of lakes and 22 acres of wetlands, the golf course offers residency to migratory waterfowl in the area. Kizer is suitable for players of all levels. Ample fairways and the choice of five sets of tees provides each golfer the opportunity to play a course that fits their skill level and a variety of ways to negotiate the challenges set forth.

Pine Forest Golf Club

Lady Bird Johnson Golf Course

Wolfdancer Golf Club

Wolfdancer offers players three distinct terrains on which to test their game: rolling prairie land, a heavily wooded ridgeline and a river valley dotted with native pecan trees. The course rambles over a dramatic stretch of terrain with oak, cedar elm and pecan trees and cut by the Colorado River.

ShadowGlen Golf

ShadowGlen is just north east of Austin in Manor. The course opened in 2004 and is well deserving of it's rating as Golf Digest's "Top 10 Best New Golf Courses." It was built and designed by renowned architects Roy Bechtol and Randy Russell.

Point Venture Golf Course

Designed by local Texan, Gary Stephenson, KTGC serves as an extension of the natural landscape - blending grades of edges, slopes, and contours of the landscape into its striped fairways and angulated greens. Each hole provides an avenue of play with varied angles that allow golfers of any skill level to enjoy the game and feel challenged.

Pedernales Golf Club (AKA Willie Nelson's Cut-N-Putt)

Austin Country Club

This 180-acre golf course is the third home for Austin Country Club since its founding in 1899. Designed by Pete Dye, whom Golfweek Magazine named one of the top architects in the world, the course has been characterized as a "complex and guileful challenge".

Avery Ranch Golf Club

The 18-hole championship course offers 5 tee placements that provide an enjoyable golfing experience for all levels of players. The course boasts "the best finishing hole in Austin".

Great Hills Country Club

The Hills Country Club

The Hills Country Club offers two stunning championship courses by world-famous, industry renowned Nicklaus Design. The Hills was the first golf course in Austin designed exclusively by Jack Nicklaus. Flintrock Falls, the second course, was designed by both Jack Nicklaus and Jack Nicklaus II.

Lakeway Country Club

Lakeway Country Club features 36 holes of incredible golf in Austin played over two very unique layouts. Both the Live Oak and Yaupon golf courses offer various challenges with rolling hills, blind tee shots and tree-lined fairways. Live Oak features a par-3 hole No. 3, commonly referred to as "Jaws." The hole plays 204 yards from the gold tees over a deep ravine that gobbles up any shot that falls short of the green. Yaupon features hole No. 18, a 503-yard par-5, playing downhill to a pond with a 50-foot drop in elevation. After successfully crossing the pond, you are challenged with an approach shot, which rises 40 feet to a tricky green.

Lakecliff Golf Club

Rolling hills, natural plateaus, soft contours and native vegetation are harmoniously woven into a playable championship layout that provides a variety of interesting holes to delight members and visitors alike.

Fazio Canyons

The 7,153-yard, par-72 layout boasts the signature of Tom Fazio, the legendary golf designer of Barton Creek's 18-hole Fazio Foothill's course. Fazio's masterpiece is located just two miles from the Austin resort and has its own pro shop, extensive practice areas, and is the home of the revered Barton Creek Golf Academy.

Fazio Foothills

The golf course is an astonishingly beautiful design masterpiece by Tom Fazio. Its architectural layout features dramatic cliff-lined fairways, natural limestone caves, waterfalls, and superb TiffEagle Bermuda greens, which gives golfers 18 holes of pure pleasure with no lack of challenge. This unforgettable golfing experience provides plenty of elevation change and visual impact.

Palmer Lakeside

Ideally perched on a secluded hilltop overlooking Lake Travis, just 25 miles west of Barton Creek Resort & Spa in Austin, Palmer Lakeside is a hidden retreat that rewards guests with striking panoramic lake views and twilight glimpses of whitetail deer.

River Place Country Club

Apple Rock

Widely known as one of the most scenic courses in the state, this spectacular course spans 147 acres of the rolling Texas Hill Country along the shores of Lake LBJ.

Escondido Golf Club

Ram Rock

With its dramatic elevation changes, Ram Rock offers enough length and difficulty to challenge scratch players in any group and features an especially demanding island green par 3 hole.

Slick Rock

Slick Rock embodies the Robert Trent Jones, Sr. philosophy of "hard par, easy bogey." It's also home to the awe-inspiring "Million Dollar Hole" (No. 14) featuring a winding cart path that takes golfers on a ride through a waterfall that spans more than 35 yards and empties more than 8,000 gallons of water into Slick Rock creek every minute.

Summit Rock

Horseshoe Bay Resort's most exclusive Members-Only course is known as the best new golf course in the United States (Ron Whitten of Golf Digest). It officially opened in October 2012 when Nicklaus himself, opened the course by playing a few holes in front of a large gallery.

The Legends Golf Course (Semi-Private)
